## *Solo & Ensemble Contest*

Solo & Ensemble provides flutists the opportunity to play a selection of their choice for critique by a qualified judge at the festival on Saturday March 8, 2008. Flutists may play a solo, with or without piano accompaniment, or as part of an ensemble.

Each participating soloist or ensemble will receive a rating of Superior Plus, Superior, Excellent, Good, or Needs Work. Superior Plus requires that the selection be memorized. Certificates will be awarded with outstanding entries to be recognized at the Gala Saturday night concert.

The non-refundable entry fee is \$10.00 for a soloist, or \$5.00 *per person per ensemble*. *There is no fee for accompanists.*

Solo & Ensemble participating flutists are required to pay the non-refundable festival registration fee, which includes membership in the flute society. Non-flutist ensemble members are NOT required to pay festival and membership fees unless they plan to attend festival activities.

## *Requirements*

1. Any flutist may participate in the contest, regardless of age or skill level.
2. Participants will play selections not exceeding ten minutes in length.
3. All applicants must submit a complete Solo & Ensemble form (see website) accompanied by appropriate fees, postmarked no later than February 22, 2008.
